CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ALICE HEWES 64187 UPPER ROCK CREEK ROAD ARLINGTON, OREGON 97812

confirms the right to use the waters of ROCK CREEK, SPRING, AND RESERVOIR, constructed under Permit R-4860, tributaries to the JOHN DAY RIVER for IRRIGATION of 81.2 ACRES and FISH CULTURE.

This right was perfected under Permit 31948. The date of priority is OCTOBER 17, 1966 for 2.0 cubic feet per second from Rock Creek, and JANUARY 12, 1967 for 0.10 cubic foot second from Spring. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 2.10 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS); BEING 2.00 CFS FROM ROCK CREEK FOR IRRIGATION and 0.10 CFS FROM SPRING AND RESERVOIR FOR FISH CULTURE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
