CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of DESCHUTES RIVER, tributary to COLUMBIA RIVER, for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat and other ecological values.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for DESCHUTES County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 12, at Page 282, and in Volume 16, at Pages 1 and 390. The date of priority is OCTOBER 31, 1900 and DECEMBER 2, 1907. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed the quantities described below:

To Lake Billy Chinook at approximately RM 120.

The instream right established by this Allocation of Conserved Water shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.348 or 537.470, unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 83571, and any related decree.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of thisorder. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
