CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

Norvil Greener Halfway, Oregon 97834

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST PINE CREEK FOR TRACT #1 and CLEAR CREEK FOR TRACT #2, tributaries of PINE CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 117.0 acres, DOMESTIC and STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 11, at Page 235. The date of priority is 1877 for Tract #1 and 1879 for Tract #2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, measured at the point of diversion, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1.0 acre-foot per acre during July, 1.0 acre-foot per acre during August, and 0.5 acre-foot per acre during September, during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

TRACT #2

NW1/4 SW1/4 5.0 ACRES 5.0 ACRES SW14 SW14 SE14 SW14 15.0 ACRES SECTION 10

TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 46 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 10316, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered <u>August 26, 2005</u>, approving Transfer Application T-9473 and corrects a scrivener's error in a point of diversion that was listed in previously issued Certificate 81606. This certificate supersedes Certificate 81606.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
