that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose, and shall not exceed 0.07 cable foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereander shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

32 acres in the SE, of NEW of Section Two (2), Township Fifteen (15) South, Range Ten (10) East of Willemette Meridian, in Grock County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
