CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STEVEN LYNN STONEBREAKER
63235 HALLEY ROAD
LAGRANDE OREGON 97850

confirms the right to use the waters of the GRANDE RONDE RIVER, a tributary to the SNAKE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 49.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 8, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1872.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre in any irrigation season diverted at a rate of not to exceed ONE-FORTIETH of a cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 79512, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOV 19 2009, approving Transfer Application T-10452 for a change in PLACE OF USE.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
