confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH MYRTLE CREEK, a tributary to MYRTLE CREEK for IRRIGATION of 6.47 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-5877. The date of priority is MAY 12, 1923. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.085 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
