 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CRAIG APREGAN

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the WHYCHUS CREEK BASIN for PRIMARY IRRIGATION of 1.3 acres and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 6.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-7092. The date of priority is DECEMBER 26, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.093 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right shall be limited to any deficiencies in the available supply of any prior right for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE and DIMINISHMENT OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 21, 2005, at Special Order Volume 67, Page 177, approving Transfer Application T-9571, and together with Certificate 81476, supercedes Certificate 74143, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
