CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

F. C. Vaughan
Baker, Oregon

confirms the right to use the waters of overflow from City of Baker's Reservoir, a tributary of the Powder River, for IRRIGATION of 51.35 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-7275. The date of priority is April 13, 1926.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for the described purposes and shall not exceed 0.63 cubic foot per second (CFS), or the equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 49963, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JAN 15 2010, and recorded in Special Order Volume 80, Page 100, canceling a portion of the water right. This certificate supersedes Certificate 49963.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
