 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS, within the EAST PRONG WALLA WALLA RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION of 4.3 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 5.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-5460. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 17, 1971. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.12 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water at the additional point of appropriation shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.


The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 22, 2007, at Special Order Volume 72, Page 474, approving Transfer Application T-10056, and supersedes Certificate 46353, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Resources Review Board.
