CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM SMITH PRINEVILLE, OR 97754

confirms the right to use the waters of MILL CREEK, a tributary of CROOKED RIVER for STOCK USE AND IRRIGATION of 60 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 303. The date of priority is 1870. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially. The right allows the use of a reasonable amount for STOCK USE, and the amount used for IRRIGATION shall not exceed 0.75 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
