confirms the right to use the waters of the POWDER RIVER, a tributary to the SNAKE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 156.85 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 296. The date of priority is APRIL 19, 1910. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.96 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
