CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GARRY WILLIAMS and

confirms the right to use the waters of NAROMA CREEK, tributary to LITTLE NORTH FORK SANTIAM RIVER for DOMESTIC USE.

This right was perfected under Permit 12231. The date of priority is JUNE 23, 1936. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the original point of diversion: NW¼ NE¼, SECTION 15, T 9 S, R 2 E, W.M.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
9 S	2 E	WM	10	SW SE	950 FEET EAST AND 192 FEET NORTH 5° WEST FROM THE S¼ CORNER, SECTION 10

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LAND ON WHICH THE WATER IS TO BE USED IS A PART OF THE PROPERTY MORE EXPLICITLY DESCRIBED BY APPROPRIATOR AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT A POINT, AT AN IRON PIPE ON THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 10 IN TOWNSHIP 9-SOUTH, RANGE 2 EAST OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN IN MARION COUNTY, STATE OF OREGON, WHICH POINT IS 950 FEET EAST OF THE QUARTER SECTION CORNER ON THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID SECTION; THENCE WEST ALONG THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID SECTION 100 FEET; THENCE NORTH TO THE CENTER LINE OF THE LITTLE NORTH FORK OF THE SANTIAM RIVER; THENCE EASTERLY ALONG THE CENTER LINE OF SAID STREAM, TO A POINT WHICH IS DUE NORTH OF THE PLACE OF BEGINNING; THENCE SOUTH TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING, BEING SITUATED IN THE SW¼ OF THE SE¼ OF SAID SECTION 10.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEBRUARY 14, 1996, at Special Order Volume 50, Page 59, approving Transfer Application 7053, and together with Certificate 68779, supersedes Certificate 14610, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
