CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON  
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of the COLUMBIA RIVER tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat and other ecological values.

This right was perfected under permit 37121. The date of priority is October 3, 1973 for 3.31 CFS and December 11, 1973 for 0.89 CFS. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall be protected from April 15 through September 30.

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

From the location of the diversion authorized previously under Certificate 80912, located at:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Survey Coordinates
17 S	47 E	WM	21	NE NW	350 FEET SOUTH AND 1980 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 21

To the confluence with the PACIFIC OCEAN.

Within the specified stream reach, the amount of water to which this right is entitled shall not exceed the quantity of water legally available at the original point of diversion.

The instream right established by this ALLOCATION OF CONSERVED WATER shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.348 or 537.470, unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

This Certificate supersedes Certificate 85670 which was issued to confirm an ALLOCATION OF CONSERVED WATER approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 78, Page 425, approving Conserved Water Application CW-58.

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 80912, and any related decree.
