CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

GRANTS PASS OR 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of the APPELGATE LAKE RESERVOIR, a tributary to the APPELGATE RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 13.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-46416. The date of priority is AUGUST 17, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 28.72 ACRE FEET, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 1-07-10-W0287, or a satisfactory replacement, between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to correct a scrivener's error in the use described in Certificate 66906. This certificate supersedes Certificate 66906, to describe that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 63299, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 12, 1991, approving Transfer Application T-6419.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within 60 days of the date of service.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
