CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DOROTHY LIVINGSTON SIMS
2316 JULIA COURT
PINOLE, CA 94564

confirms the right to use the waters of CROOKED RIVER, a tributary of DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 34.2 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is 1903.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.43 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs), the total quantity being limited to four (4.0) acre feet per acre during each year. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The point of diversion is located as follows:



This certificate corrects scrivener errors in the certificate recorded at page 86121, State Record of Water Right Certificates. Certificate 86121 erroneously described the place of use. Certificate 86121 confirmed the change in point of diversion authorized by an order of the director entered on May 25, 1976, and recorded in Special Order Volume 27, pages 209 to 211, approving Transfer Application T-3286, and was issued to correct Certificate 47267.

Certificate 47267 was incorrectly issued in the name of Low Line Ditch Company. The order directed that a certificate be issued to Dorothy B. Sims upon a determination of satisfactory proof of completion of the authorized change in point of diversion. This corrected certificate supersedes certificate 86121.

The said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
