CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PORTLAND GENERAL ELECTRIC CO.
121 SW SALMON ST
PORTLAND OR 97204

confirms the right to use the waters of the COLUMBIA RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN for NUCLEAR PLANT COOLING AND FIRE SUPPRESSION SYSTEM.

This right was perfected under Permit S-34940. The date of priority is AUGUST 3, 1970. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 81.1 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 81.1 cubic feet per second, being 0.4 CFS FOR FIRE PROTECTION, and 80.7 CFS FOR COOLING, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This use may be regulated if analysis of data available discloses that the appropriation will measurably reduce the surface water flows necessary to maintain the free-flowing character of a scenic waterway in quantities necessary for recreation, fish and wildlife in effect as of the priority date of this right or as those quantities may be subsequently reduced.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 81969, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered APR 27 2010, approving Transfer Application T-10955.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
