## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

#### THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

# CYNTHIA A. EDWARDS 13238 EAST EVANS CREEK RD ROGUE RIVER, OR 97537

confirms the right to use the waters of MAY CREEK, tributary to EVANS CREEK, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 7.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-24619. The date of priority is DECEMBER 4, 1956. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

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A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

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The quantity of water diverted at the new reach within which a portable pump diverts water, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.

Diversion of water under this right is limited to availability of water at the original diversion point on May Creek being:

When May Creek goes dry, irrigation will end under this right, even if there is still water in Evans Creek.

The water user shall maintain and operate fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with ODFW's operational and maintenance standards.

The water user shall maintain and operate the in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted, as required by the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 28, 2007, at Special Order Volume 73, Page 680, approving Transfer Application 10395, and together with Certificate 83538, supersedes Certificate 24152, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
