CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of 14 WELLS in the DESCHUTES RIVER Basin for GROUP DOMESTIC USE FOR 281 FAMILIES INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE FOR EACH.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10000. The date of priority is JULY 10, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially per well as described below, and shall not exceed 250 GALLONS PER MINUTE (GPM) in any combination from the wells, measured at the point of appropriations, if available at the original point of appropriation.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

The well(s) shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The water user shall maintain meters or other suitable devices in good working order, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month.

If substantial or undue interference with an existing well used under an existing right, including existing exempt uses, occurs, and such interference can be shown to the satisfaction of the Department, the use of water from the wells authorized by this right causing the interference shall be regulated to mitigate the interference.


Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.
