 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ED BECHTEL AND MAYBELL BECHTEL
 SELMA OR 97538

confirms the right to use the waters of DEER CREEK, a tributary to the ILLINOIS RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 21.7 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 13, at Page 70. The date of priority is 1885 for 0.434 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs).

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed ONE CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND for each 50 acres of land irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1 of each year and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


NOTE: 0.226 cfs is awarded for the irrigation of the above described land with a date of priority of July 7, 1932, in addition to that allowed above.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 13831, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered APR 08 2010, approving Transfer Application T-10794 and the provisions of a partial cancellation order recorded at Special Order Volume 13, Page 492.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
