CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of CROOKED RIVER, tributary to DESCHUTES RIVER for IRRIGATION of 44.9 ACRES, AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 26.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 42025. The date of priority is JANUARY 2, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.8 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion form the source.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director originally entered December 28, 2001, at Special Order Volume 55, Pages 1372 through 1383, approving Transfer Application T-8827, further superseded by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 6, 2007, at Special Order Volume 71, Pages 462 through 474, correcting a scrivener's error, and supersedes Certificate 67912, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
