CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

IVERSON BROTHERS 33739 S MERIDIAN RD WOODBURN OR 97071

confirms the right to use the waters of SANTIAM RIVER AND WILLAMETTE BASIN PROJECT RESERVOIRS CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-1625, tributaries of WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 370.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 51561. The date of priority is MARCH 16, 1990. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 4.49 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 1.86 CFS FROM POINT OF DIVERSION 1 AND 2.63 CFS FROM POINT OF DIVERSION 2 or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage.

The use of water for irrigation is limited to the period of March 1 through October 31 of each year.

The use of stored water under this right is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract No. 0-07-10-W0811 or a satisfactory replacement between the Bureau of Reclamation and the water user, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director.

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be operated to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife specifications.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.
