CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

EDWARD E MACDONALD 1701 FROZEN CREEK MYRTLE CREEK OR 97457

confirms the right to use the waters of FROZEN CREEK, tributary to NORTH MYRTLE CREEK for IRRIGATION of 25.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 2845. The date of priority is MARCH 1, 1916. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.32 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the authorized point of diversion, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the original point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION AND CORRECTING THE PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 30, 1992, at Special Order Volume 46, Page 548, approving Transfer Application 6684, and supersedes Certificate 1218, State record of Water Right Certificates.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
