CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of Walla Walla River, a tributary of Columbia River, for irrigation of 9.4 acres. Use of water under this right shall not exceed a total of 0.26 cubic feet per second (cfs), as further limited below.

This right was confirmed, in part, by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 12 at Page 9. The date of priority for irrigation of 5.6 acres, as described below, is 1891. The use is limited to 1.5 miner's inches per acre, or 0.21 cubic foot per second (cfs), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. This portion of the right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

A portion of this right was perfected under Permit S-1299. The date of priority for irrigation of 3.8 acres is July 23, 1912, as further described below. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.05 cfs or its equivalent in case of rotation. The amount of water used for irrigation under this portion of the right shall be limited to 1/80 of one cfs per acre and shall conform to reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
