## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL within the WALLA WALLA RIVER BASIN, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 49.2 acres.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.62 cubic feet per second (cfs) or its equivalent in case of rotation, if available at the original well.
