 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of Walla Walla River, a tributary of Columbia River, for irrigation of 2.60 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit S-1300. The date of priority is July 23, 1912. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This certificate confirms an order of the Water Resources Director entered on May 27, 2010, and recorded in Special Order Volume 80 Page 154, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes the relevant portions of water right Certificate 949.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
