CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of WALLA WALLA RIVER, a tributary of SNAKE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 0.87.

This right was perfected under Permit S-1299 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the State Water Board of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1, at page 236, on the 8th day of February, 1917. The date of priority is July 23, 1912.

The use is limited to 0.011 cubic foot per second (cfs), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source, being 0.005 cfs for irrigation and 0.0063 cfs for supplemental irrigation.

The point of diversion are located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

This certificate describes the portion of Certificate 1322 NOT modified by an order of the Water Resources Director entered on May 27, 2010, and recorded in Special Order Volume 80, Page 1154 approving a petition by Walla Walla River Improvement District under ORS 541.327 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes, in part, water right Certificate 1322.
