CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of a well in the WALLA WALLA RIVER BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 3.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit U-82. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 27, 1934. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.13 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The point of appropriation is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-THIRTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate describes a portion of Certificate 80260 diminished by an order of the Water Resources Director entered on May 27, 2010 and recorded in Special Order Volume 80, Page 154 approving a petition by Walla Walla River Improvement District under ORS 541.327 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes, in part, water right Certificate 80260.
