CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DAVID AND KATHY LECOMPTE
9785 PORTLAND ROAD NE
SALEM OR 97305

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS in the SILVER CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION of 1.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6370. The date of priority is June 25, 1975. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the two wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The 1.9 acres of irrigation described above are for the same lands authorized under Certificate 47941, but have been redescribed.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the authorized point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.


The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND SUBSTITUTION OF SUPPLEMENTAL GROUND WATER RIGHTS FOR PRIMARY SURFACE WATER RIGHTS approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 29, 2009, at Special Order Volume 78, Page 235, approving Transfer Application T-8441, and together with Certificate 82904, supersedes Certificate 47936, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The substitution of a supplemental right from a ground water source for primary water rights from surface source may be terminated upon a request by the water right holder or by order of the Director if the Director determines that the use of the ground water as primary irrigation causes injury. Upon termination, the substituted primary and supplemental water rights shall revert to their original status.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
