CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RAYMOND C AND DEANNA E DONACA
545 NE 7TH ST
PRINEVILLE OR 97754

confirms the right to use the waters of MCKAY CREEK, tributary to CROOKED RIVER for IRRIGATION of 6.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permits E-192 and E-193. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 22, 1913. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.07 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install headgates and measuring devices, the diversion works shall include in-line flow meters, a weir, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The types and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 23, 1981, at Special Order Volume 34, Pages 470 to 471, approving Transfer Application 4699, and together with Certificate 51126, supersedes Certificate 1683, State record of Water Right Certificates.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
