confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the DESCHUTES BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 14.86 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10670. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 25, 1986. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.19 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
