CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JIMMIE D. AND PHILLIS WRAY
12000 MODOC ROAD
CENTRAL POINT OR 97502

confirms the right to use the waters of the ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN for IRRIGATION OF 1.41 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-9600. The date of priority is MARCH 29, 1930. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.016 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

35 S	1 W	WM	31	NW SE	4	1650 FEET NORTH AND 2050 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 31

The amount of water used for irrigation, under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 65061, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUN 28 2010, approving Transfer Application T-10664.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
