CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 3, within the COLUMBIA RIVER BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATING 40.5 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit U-184. The date of priority is JUNE 6, 1946. The right is entitled to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.48 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of ONE-SIXTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
