## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LESTER STURM 36121 STASTNY ROAD MALIN OREGON 97632

confirms the right to use the waters of SIMMS RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-252, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 58.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 2466. The date of priority is MAY 24, 1915. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.73 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
