CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CITY OF THE DALLES
313 COURT
THE DALLES OR 97058

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, tributary to MILL CREEK BASIN for MUNICIPAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit U-189. The date of priority is OCTOBER 4, 1945. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.69 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND and restricted to use during the irrigation season of each year from April 1 to October 1, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of appropriation is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.



This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 9, 1995, at Special Order Volume 49, Pages 260 through 262, approving Transfer Application T-7258, and together with Certificate 85886, supercedes Certificate 44783, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
