The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.20 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the original point of diversion; NW ¼ NE ¼, Section 24, Township 13 South, Range 26 East, WM; Cummings Ditch – 1,200 feet South and 2,650 feet East from the NW corner of Section 24; or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
