 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GLENN S. CHOWNING

confirms the right to use the waters of DEEP WELL NO. 2 AND HILLVIEW WELL NO. 4 in the UMATILLA BASIN for IRRIGATION of 11.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9811. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 4, 1982. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.14 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The wells are located as follows:

Hillview Well No. 4	4 N	25 E	WM	13	SE NE	3840 FEET NORTH AND 2440 FEET EAST FROM S1/4 CORNER, SECTION 13

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The wells shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifers (water sources) as the original point of appropriation.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The original point of appropriation was:


The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.

The water user shall maintain in-line flow meters or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 8, 2005, at Special Order Volume 66, Page 60, approving Transfer Application T-8376, and supersedes Certificate 80375, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
