 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JAMES W. MASON, JR.

confirms the right to use the waters of a an UNNAMED SLOUGH, tributary of East Fork Silvies River, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 44.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-49406. The date of priority is JUNE 5, 1985. The right is limited to not more than 0.55 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that although declared herein to be for supplemental irrigation, the right may, in the interest of conserving the ground water supplies, be exercised at times when water is available in the ground water supply appropriated under the right perfected under Permit G-10512, provided that the total quantity diverted from both sources of supply shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 82845, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered **JUL 02 2010**, approving Transfer Application T-10437 and corrects the name of the stream the unnamed slough flows into.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within 60 days of the date of service.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
