confirms the right to use the waters of DITCH CREEK, tributary to HOOD RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 30.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Hood River County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at Page 200. The date of priority is JULY, 1902. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 9 MINERS INCHES, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The transfer that this certificate confirms combined two rights. These two rights shall not be split.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 30, 1992, at Special Order Volume 46, Page 545, approving Transfer Application 6672, and together with Certificate 67945, supersedes Certificate 14993, State record of Water Right Certificates.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
