CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BARRY BUSHUE 9880 SE REVENUE ROAD BORING, OR 97009

confirms the right to use the waters of a Well, in the Johnson Creek Basin, for IRRIGATION of 45.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-5784. The date of priority is MAY 4, 1973. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.24 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed and to which such right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued in accordance with OAR 690-380-6010 to describe the water right for a non-completed change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 30, 1991, at Special Order Volume 45, Page 23,3 approving Transfer Application T-6455 and supersedes Certificate 45138, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
