CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of UNNAMED STREAM, tributary to WEST FORK WILLIAMS CREEK for IRRIGATION of 0.6 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 18096. The date of priority is JANUARY 9, 1948. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.008 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the original point of diversion, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2 to October 31 of each year from direct flow.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered October 14, 1991, at Special Order Volume 45, Page 443, approving Transfer Application 6216, and together with Certificate 66810, supercedes Certificate 19545, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
