confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH SANTIAM RIVER, tributary to SANTIAM RIVER for FLOW AUGMENTATION.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Linn County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 18, at Page 15. The date of priority is 1874.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 85.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), measured at the point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring devices at the point of diversion and the six points of re-diversion in good working order.

The water user shall measure and report the augmentation flows entering the Calapooia River from Oak Creek, including those originating from Cathey Creek. For purposes of measurement and reporting, the augmentation flows shall be measured at a location acceptable to the Department, as described below. The measurement and reporting shall be done on a weekly basis from July 15 through September 30, or as necessary to ensure continued protection of the instream water right established by certificate 66857. The Director may modify or waive the time period and frequency when flows need to be measured and reported in order to ensure that the instream water right established by certificate 66857 is not injured.

Oak Creek augmentation flows shall be measured downstream of re-diversion point #4 and as close to the confluence of the unnamed canal along Lochner Road and Oak Creek as possible, unless the Department determines that measuring at the point of diversion or an intermediary point is acceptable.

Cathey Creek augmentation flows shall be measured downstream of re-diversion point #5 and as close to the confluence of Cathey Creek and Oak Creek as possible. The Department has determined that measuring at Park Terrace SW Road is acceptable. Any change in location of this downstream measuring point must receive prior approval by the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 26, 2005, at Special Order Volume 66, Page 127, approving Transfer Application T-9373, and together with Certificate 81570, supercedes Certificate 49387, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject all conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
