CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

OREGON POTATO, INC.
 PO BOX 216
 BOARDMAN, OR 97818

confirms the right to use the waters of the COLUMBIA RIVER , a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 42.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 31346. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 23, 1966. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.72 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND , or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 79941, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 10 2010, approving Transfer Application T-10998 and cancelling a portion of this right and to correct a scrivener's error in describing the point of diversion location.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
