CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 3, tributary to WILDHORSE CREEK for MUNICIPAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit U-596. The date of priority is JANUARY 4, 1954. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.35 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the original well, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well) shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation, located as follows:

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 12, 1995, at Special Order Volume 49, Page 154, approving Transfer Application 6593, and supersedes Certificate 22895, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
