CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

NORPAC FOODS INC.

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 1, WELL 2, WELL 3 (HYDRAULICALLY CONNECTED WELLS), AND AN UNNAMED CHANNEL OF THE NORTH SANTIAM RIVER, tributaries to the SANTIAM RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 62.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 25143. The date of priority is JUNE 20, 1952. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.78 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the original points of diversion: N½ NE¼, SECTION 20, T 9 S, R 1 W, W.M.; or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the old points of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original points of diversion.

The water user shall maintain and operate a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

This certificate is issued to confirm An ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 1, 1997, at Special Order Volume 51, Page 1329, approving Transfer Application 7244, and confirming Transfer Application 6634.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
