CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PETER L. and BILLEE K. STEMPL
4866 UPPER APPLGATE ROAD
JACKSONVILLE OR 97530

confirms the right to use the waters of APPLGATE RIVER, tributary to ROGUE RIVER for DOMESTIC, LIVESTOCK and IRRIGATION of 6.7 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, Page 1. The date of priority is 1876. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.167 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


The water user shall maintain the fish screening device, as appropriate, consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife standards.

The water user shall maintain the in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in Point of Diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 24, 2009, at Special Order Volume 77, Page 549, approving Transfer Application T-10704, and together with Certificate 85371, supersedes Certificate 52560, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
