CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of UMATILLA RIVER, tributary to COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 12.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at Page 127. The date of priority is 1905.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.15 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, subject to the provisions of paragraph 33 of said decree and all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree, if available at the original point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain the headgate, in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 12, 2004, at Special Order Volume 59, Page 16, as modified by Special Order Volume 60, Page 80, approving Transfer Application 7293, and together with Certificate 80550, supercedes Certificate 51218, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
