CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HILLVIEW DAIRY INC. PO BOX 172 BOARDMAN, OR 97818

confirms the right to use the waters of a TILE DRAIN LINE, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 22.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-3231. The date of priority is MARCH 30, 1966. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.28 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate corrects a scrivener error in the certificate recorded at page 86495, State Record of Water Right Certificates. Certificate 86495 erroneously described the point of diversion. Certificate 86495 described the remaining portion of water right Certificate 79938, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 10, 2010, and recorded in Special Order Volume 81, pages 646 to 660, approving Transfer Application T-10998 and canceling a portion of the water right described by Certificate 79938. This Certificate supersedes Certificate 86495.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
