 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

KATHERINE GEISLER
 MT. VERNON, OR 97865

confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary to the COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 10.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 18828. The date of priority is JUNE 28, 1949. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.265 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twsp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q - Q	Measured Distances
13 S	29 E	WM	27	NW NE	50 Feet South and 3380 Feet East from the NW Corner of Section 27

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion not to exceed FIVE ACRE-FEET per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1 to September 30 of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
