CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

KATHERINE GEISLER
MT. VERNON, OR 97865

confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary to the COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 1.7 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1906.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q - Q	Measured Distances
13 S	29 E	WM	27	NW NE	50 Feet South and 3380 Feet East from the NW Corner of Section 27

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to September 30; further limited to 1.0 acre-foot per acre per calendar month to July 1 and 3/4 acre-foot per acre thereafter; total 5.0 acre-feet per acre for season, measured at the point of diversion. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 39357, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 27 2010, approving Transfer Application T-10630.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
