CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MARK AND JOLLY KRAUTMANN 4194 71ST AVE SE SALEM OR 97301

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH SANTIAM RIVER AND DETROIT RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-1625, tributary to SANTIAM RIVER for IRRIGATION of 21.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 39478. The date of priority is JUNE 4, 1975. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.27 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-1625, and is subject to the terms and conditions of contract No. 14-06-100-8849 or a satisfactory replacement between the Bureau of Reclamation and the water user, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

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The quantity of diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered October 5, 1994, at Special Order Volume 48, Page 314, approving Transfer Application 6786, and, supersedes Certificate 48064, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
